AGRION Membership in 2020

- Current number of members: 53
- Awaiting membership: 4
- AGRION members are accepted by the General Assembly, which was canceled in March due to COVID-19 measures.



AGRION at the time of COVID-19

Four months that verified the validity of our organization:

- daily distribution of information to members
- communication with competent institutions (a state of emergency was declared in Slovakia)
- preparation of applications and treasures
- Legislative provision for the continuous operation of the sale of agricultural machinery service



Due to COVID-19, we had interrupted or canceled planned events:

- Canceled AGRION University (13 lectures from top experts from our companies) at the Slovak University of Agriculture in Nitra, which aims to bring practical knowledge to students of the only faculty focused on agricultural technology in Slovakia.
- Canceled AGRION General Assembly in March, postponed indefinitely (still not held).
- The Agromechatronics Competition 2020 has been canceled, which was intended for students of secondary vocational schools where the Agromechatronics department is taught.



Field days and in exhibions 2020

All agricultural exhibitions were canceled in the first half of the year due to COVID-19 measures, or took place in a restricted mode.

Canceled agricultural exhibitions:

- Field Day focused on fodder, May 2020 canceled
- Slovak field days, July 2020 in limited mode
- Exhibition Agrokomplex, August 2020 canceled

The Slovak Republic was the Corn Field Day on September 17, 2020, which organized AGRION. We have been preparing this exhibition since 2004.
