

Future of CLIMMAR

Preface (1):

- In 2019, first during the Spring meeting in Naples and later on during the Congress in Thun, we discussed the Future of CLIMMAR and the possibility to make some organisational changes.
- During these discussions we came to three main conclusions:
 - We recognised the major added value of CLIMMAR for the national organisations.
 - We recognised that there is a potential to do more.
 - We recognised that we have to be careful in the cost/benefit ratio.
- In Thun, we also came to the conclusion that for the future of CLIMMAR it might be necessary to become an independent organization with an own juridical identity and a more permanent location and dedicated staff for the secretariat. This off course, with respect to the budgetary space and limits.

Preface (2):

- Beginning February 2021 a letter was send to all CLIMMAR members to investigate their opinion on 4 ideas for change:
 - On Juridical Identity
 - On Location
 - On organizational structure of staff and Presidency
 - On the Statutes
- All reactions of the members were put into one overall document which was send back for this Spring meeting to form the basis for further elaboration on the future of CLIMMAR.
- Result of this Spring meeting consultation on the reactions on the 4 ideas should lead
 to the establishment of a working group with the mandate to make a total and
 integrated proposal for the Future of CLIMMAR. This integrated proposal is to be
 decided on at a later moment by all CLIMMAR members

Idea:

Suggestion would be to use the Belgian law for the juridical identity of CLIMMAR and form a so called VZW (non-profit association). This type of identity is what most European associations are using.

Discussion on Future of CLIMMAR part: Juridical Identity

Progress:

We have already done some first investigation on the possibilties for setting up a VZW (non-profit association) under Belgian law. We have established first contacts with VSDC, an Belgian organisation specialised in advise on becoming a VZW status under Belgium law. They seem to be the right organisation to handle this item in a professional way.

Advise:

Continuation with the contacts with VSCD to elaborate the idea of Juridical Identity further.

As most European (umbrella) sector organisations/ associations are based in Brussels, we believe the most logical location for CLIMMAR would be Brussels.

Discussion on Future of CLIMMAR part: Location

Progress:

Some first investigations have been made based on the reactions of the members on this Idea:

- Holding office within one of the EU insititution buildings itself > not possible
- Holding office within premesis FEDAGRIM office > first conclusion: not favourable, look further
- Holding office within other (lobby) organisations:
 - First talks with SME-United
 - First talks with AECDR

Both organisations are specialist in lobby activities, have offices in Brussels, will make a first proposal for CLIMMAR on short term

Advise:

Continuation with the established first contacts with the other organisations and wait for their proposals. Mandate the Working Group to elaborte further on this.



Discussion on Future of CLIMMAR part: Organization structure of Staff and Presidency

Idea:

- enlist a dedicated and permanent General Secretary, starting on parttime basis, for CLMMAR, stationed and holding office in Brussels.
- The Presidency (President and Vice Presidents) can rotate every 3
 years amongst the members in a fixed scheme. In this way we can
 ensure better continuation of the day to day work, on the right
 location for the work.

Discussion on Future of CLIMMAR part: Statutes change

Idea:

The current CLIMMAR statutes date back from 1991. A revision is needed in the light of the suggested changes on the organization of CLIMMAR. Furthermore, as we also discussed at the congress in Thun, one important item in the Statutes to carefully look at, is **the wording of the decision making process and voting system** within CLIMMAR. This is especially important when it comes to decisions on expressing a common CLIMMAR point of view on certain lobby issues where CLIMMAR might be involved in. A possible formulation in the new Statutes is to be made with respect to the opinions of our members in this matter.

Progress:

By our contacts with the VSDC on the Juridical Indentity we came to know they also have the service to advise and help with the judgement of Statutes and formulation of new ones. This is a logical adjustment to their services since the Statutes must be in line with the Juridical Indentity of a Non-Profit Assocation (VZW) This service might be helpfull in the near future.

Advise:

- Mandate the Working Group to make a first draft of the new Statutes of CLIMMAR with respect to the wishes of the members.
- Ask VSDC for legal judgement of the new Statutes when the Working Group is ready drafting.
