Further challenges in Austria

- International energy market is a big reason for inflation
- Inflation rate in Austria was in August at 7.5 %
- Inflation rate in Austria was in September at 6.1 %
- Inflation rate should fall in 2024
- Austria is in a short recession, growth is expected to return in 2024
- CO2-Tax: 32,5 Euro per ton
- High fuel prices
- Price policy puts high pressure on traders
- Higher Wages: 11,6% higher wages are demanded by the union
- Russian gas is still a main factor for Austrian power supply
- The share of Russian gas in Austria is 60 %

- Winter 2022/23 was too dry and hot
- Spring 2023 was one of the most 15 rainy-springs in the history of measurements
- Summer characterized by heat waves
- Higher number of crop failures
- Big influence in the alpine region
- Many floods and mudslides
- Big economic damage
- High number of buildings were destroyed
