

Total 123 members



In november 2012 ML became a partner in one of the leading upper secondary schools for machine technicians, Nifsarpsskolan in Eksjö, Småland, Sweden. ML owns 30 %, the county of Eksjö 40 %, and the staff and chief 30 %.

Nifsarpsskolan is a modern school with capacity of 200 students and educates in all types of vehicles and transport programmes.

ML is looking forward to support this excellent school to be even better and hopefully increase the amount of qualified machine technicians.

MaskinExpo fair






The fair took place in May 2013 and had over 22 000 visitors and 338 exhibitors.
