Presentation of the CLIMMAR activities on Skills competitions and a short preview of the Euroskills in Göteborg, Sweden





Aim of the working group

Goal: To increase quantity & quality of inflow young people and develop staff to the required qualification levels

Result: Development of participation in Euroskills to <u>75%</u> in 2018, initiation of education improvement plan in participating countries



The working group on Education and Training

The first purpose of the working group is to promote:

- our jobs
- the training schools for mechanics
- Euroskills competitions achieve this purpose, as a continuous process in the different participating countries.



One of the best promotion action is The skills competition

After the experience of the Climmar skills (2 editions), we decided to join the organisation Worldskills Europe, and to be a partner member of the Euroskills organisation.

This participation started for the Spa competitions in 2012.

The work done in each country for the promotion and the success in Lille convinced us to pursue the collaboration until at least the 2016 competitions.

The next Euroskills competitions will be held in Sweden in Gothenburg from November 30th to December 3rd, 2016.





Main results of the survey presented in Stockholm in 2015

concerning the participation in Euroskills

- For the 7 participating countries (Austria, Denmark, France, Germany, Latvia, Switzerland, The Netherlands) different organisations for the national contest in terms of communication, participation, partnership, budget. The success depends on the relations between the Worldskills partner of the country and the profession.
- Example of France: a contest in each of the 13 (new) regions and a national contest at the end.





Main results of the survey presented in Stockholm in 2015 concerning the participation in Euroskills

- For the 8 not participating countries (Belgium, Czech Republic, Hungary, Italy, Luxemburg, Slovakia, Sweden, UK), the reasons preventing from participating are: financial, no interest from schools, suppliers or dealers, no capacity (personnel)
- The proposed actions will be the followings: to find sponsors, to increase the coordination between the different partners, to use the communication of Worldskills itself



The next step: Euroskills 2016

- The next event will be held in Gothenburg, Sweden from 30 November to 4 December 2016
- Increase of the participation for our skill: 8
 countries instead of 7, with the arrival of Russia. All
 the countries present in 2014 will be there in 2016
 Austria, Denmark, France, Germany, Latvia, Russia,
 Switzerland, The Netherlands
- Same expert and chief expert : Paul Dijkstra (NL),
 Paul Sidler (CH) named by Climmar



The next step: Euroskills 2016

- 5 topics based on machines: engine, electronics, hydraulics, transmission, repairing
- The workshop manager and technical observer are also Climmar members: Brain Sangster (UK), Maurice Gerkeens (NL)
- Good preparation of the topics with the Forum of experts of the 8 participating countries
